Docket No. 20200226-SU – Application for certificate to provide wastewater service in Charlotte County, by Environmental Utilities, LLC.

<u>Issue 1:</u> Should the Commission grant Environmental Utilities LLC.'s petition for a temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q), F.A.C.?

Recommendation: Yes. The Utility has met the requirements found in Section 120.542, F.S., and the Commission should grant EU's petition for temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q) until the Utility has completed its permitting and is closer to the commencement of its operations. EU should file the information required to set initial rates and charges in the first quarter of 2022. EU should also be required to send a status update to the Commission every six months from the date of the order as to the status of the Utility's permitting with DEP and SWFWMD, and the anticipated date of the commencement of its operations.
